### SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

ICOPED welcomes submission of paper abstracts for possible presentation in the conference parallel sessions. Abstracts must be submitted to [icoop@up.edu.ph](mailto:icoop@up.edu.ph) not later than **31 July 2018**.

Contributors must make sure that their submitted abstract has not been presented yet in any other academic conference and should follow the guidelines provided in the **Abstract Submission Form**.

All contributed abstracts will undergo a review process by the Scientific Paper Committee of ICOOP2018 after which, result of the review and notices of acceptance will be sent out on **15 August 2018**. Contributors are allowed to submit and present more than one conference paper.

### SUBMISSION OF FULL PAPERS

Contributors whose abstracts have been accepted for presentation in the conference are encouraged to submit full paper of their study on or before **22 October 2018** to [icoop@up.edu.ph](mailto:icoop@up.edu.ph). The papers will be reviewed for possible publication in the special issue of the **Journal of Economics, Management and Agricultural Development (JEMAD)**, a peer-reviewed journal of CEM, UPLB. Full paper format will follow JEMAD's guidelines for contributors, provided herein.

In addition, the conference organizing team will be giving **“ICOOP2018 Best Paper Award”** during the closing ceremony of ICOOP2018 to recognize the most relevant and scholarly written paper presented in the parallel session.
