ICOOP2018 TRANSPORTATION GUIDE

Nearest Airport

The airport nearest to DAP Conference Center and Hotel is the Manila Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA). It is located along the border between Pasay City and Parañaque City in Metro Manila and consists of 4 passenger terminals. Going to DAP, Tagaytay is a 1.5-2 hour drive from the airport via South Luzon Expressway (SLEX) or via Coastal Road. If going through SLEX, take Santa Rosa Exit and follow the signs directly to Tagaytay. If going through Coastal Road, take the Roxas Boulevard to the Manila-Cavite Expressway and then drive through Emilio Aguinaldo Highway which will lead to the main rotunda of Tagaytay (5kms away from DAP).

How to Reach the Conference Venue

Via ICOPED shuttle service

ICOPED is offering shuttle service from the airport to DAP/nearby hotels at a fixed one-way rate of PhP800 per person. The shuttle service will be available at these times:

Date	Time
November 14 (NAIA – DAP)	11:30 AM, 3:00 PM, and 7:00 PM
November 16 (DAP – NAIA)	1:00 PM
November 17 (DAP – NAIA)	7:00 AM, and 11:00 AM

Via public transportation

For international participants, you can get to DAP, Tagaytay directly by hiring a van or an airport taxi. Taxi drivers usually charge a fixed rate or double the meter fare plus toll fees. Taxi rates to Tagaytay from NAIA is approximately PhP3,000.00 (~60USdollars) up to PhP5,000.00 (~100USdollars) depending on your negotiation skills. Participants may also avail the NAIA car rental service. Renting a car requires an International Driving Permit needed along with original domestic license. If your driver's license is not in the Roman alphabet (i.e. if it is in Arabic, Greek, Russian or Chinese) you need to bring an International Driving Permit and your domestic license. For car rental rates, please visit the NAIA's website (<https://www.manila-airport.net/car-rental.php>). These two methods are highly recommended if you are carrying large and heavy luggage.

A cheaper method for reaching DAP Tagaytay is through riding the bus. All buses to Tagaytay now stop at Uniwide Coastal Mall (MMDA Southwest Integrated Bus Terminal). In order to reach Coastal Mall from Airport, you can take a taxi with rates from PhP200.00 up to PhP500.00. Bus Fare to Tagaytay Rotonda from Coastal Mall is around PhP100.00. Travel time is around one hour and thirty minutes. From Tagaytay Rotonda, you can take a jeepney with a signboard going to People's Park (fare: ~PhP20.00) or take a tricycle (fare: up to PhP200) and drop off at DAP. Total cost would be less than PhP1,000.00 but would entail a lot of vehicle transfers and longer travel time.
